

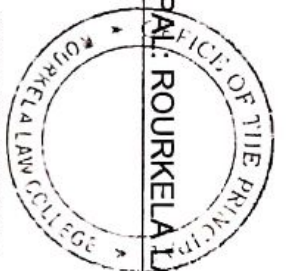

I Dibyendu Kumar Panda, Lecturer Rourkela Law College I am submitting the following report on Proctorial system.

1. I have taken all possible steps to contact the students and I could be able to contact 70 students and rest of the students could not be contacted due to telephonic problem such as lack of network and in non reachable area.

2. out of the 81 number of students whom I contacted their response is all together positive although it seems to me that there is some negative thought among themselves and I have sincerely trying to convince those students to be responsive in attending classes so good behavior to the teachers and maintain friendly relation among themselves and in this respect I am quite affirmative.

3. While contacting the students it has come to my notice that some of the students are outsiders elsewhere and attending the classes and for this reason their showing negative attitude.

4. The telephone number given by the students and proctor are not found out a times and there is a gap of communication in contacting them in over telephone.

5. The possible reason is that out of the 81 number of students some of them are outsiders and some of them are housewife. The other reason is that the first part of the study describe the development of a self report measures of reason for missing classes. Reasons included not being the mood , personal issues. Health issues, and no negative consequences. Results show that personality treats especially conscientiousness.

6. At the end of the above paras my suggestion has following strategies to improve student's attendance of classroom.

- A. Link attendance with the grades. College management should link the attendance percentage directly to the students overall grades.
- B. Then the management should try to establish a friendly atmosphere with in the institution which will attract the students. It will help to regularize the irregular students



C. Then college should take essential steps to add different curricular and co curricular activities. This can prove to be an incentive for higher attendance levels.

D. Then rewards are often the best way to get any one to do something. This can be prove to the students with highest attendance.

4. That overall the interaction was good and as expected. But telephonic conversation is not always fruitful and as a proctor I faced sort of difficulties In convincing some student over phone. But later on I managed it persuasively. Frequently I am sending various academic information via text messages to the students of the said group.
5. That in the modern education era students are less interested in orthodox teaching process. Some of the students are less aware about the future scopes of the degree they are pursuing. During the interaction process I tried to convey them various career possibilities which can be achieved by attending regular classes which may change the mindset of the students.
6. That after the above evaluation I found that the problem of students not involving with classes and the college expectedly can be overcome by adopting different motivating initiatives. Some of my suggestion to this problems are as follows:-
 - To conduct various extra-curriculum and cultural activities which will boost the interest of the students towards the college.
 - To commence the spoken English and personality development course as soon as possible.
 - To organize class seminar, debate, penal discussions, legal quiz, moot courts etc. to make the teaching and learning process more interesting.
 - To make Alumni association functional which will motivate and inspire the current students.
 - To create different Volunteer Groups and motivate them to organize various awareness camps, visit to unprivileged and other volunteer activities.

Respected Sir,

I, Tanmaya Raj Padhi, Lecturer in Law, submitting here with the report on proctorial system. On 31/01/2020 via Office Order No. RLC/495/19-20, I have been assigned as the proctor of total 78 Nos. of students (1st year-38, 2nd year-21 & final year-19). I acted accordingly to the objective and responsibilities given to me by the Chief proctor. On Completion of 1(One) month I prepared a brief monthly report as follows

1. That I have positively tried to contact each and every student of my proctorial group to discuss about their academic progress in the institution. Out of 78 Students, 67 students answered the call whereas remaining 11 students were not communicable as either their contact numbers were not reachable or switched off. Again I checked the Admission register to ascertain their alternative number but the result was the same.
2. That while interacting with the students of my proctorial group I obtained mix response from them. But majority of the students responded positively and shown their interest. While conversing with them I tried to find out the difficulties and reasons for the non-appearance of the them.
Even in some cases I have interacted with the parents and they appreciated the college management for the initiative taken.
3. That the students are on one hand interested to attain the classes regularly but on the other hand they are having various academic, personal and financial concerns. As the proctor I have tried my best to understand and solve some of the difficulties of my own. In one of the cases I took the matter to the Chief proctor and he positively dealt with the it. Other problems for irregularity of students involve change of residence, change in matrimonial status and health issues and other family


I hereby submit my report on the basic parameters.


I am being allotted 78 students as proctor under the proctorial system, 38 from 1st year, 21 from 2nd year and 19 from 3rd year. As per the instructions given, I have collected the available phone numbers from the Admission Register (office) of our college and started maintaining the proctorial system's diary from 8th Feb, 2020.

Basically, in the initial stage we were given the responsibility of procuring the attendance of the students, for which we all took initiative to call the students personally. From the above numbers of students, I was able to contact 61 numbers of students and failed to contact the other students due to various reasons such as not reachable, switched off, no. not available etc.

Out of 61 students, I found 13 to be regular and few explained their state of circumstances to be out of station, certain domestic chores. As per the conversation with few of them, they might turn up for the classes.

In my view, if any fun activities (indoor games as chess, extra-curricular activities) is done in colleges, the students might turn up.
